### **Reviews & Scheduling**

As work is being iterated, get involved (as an observer). As plans are being formed and deliverables scheduled – observe the planning.



#### **Create the Calendar**

Communications within the department and from the department. Observe sequence and consider inputs and rituals.



#### **Intentional Involvement**

It will quickly be more than you can handle. Be deliberate. What should you take over? What should be consolidated? Left Alone?
